# Fees and Payments

- Additional Responsibilities to EMSA
- Cost Neutral to State General Fund
- Fees Based on 7 New Employees, LEMSA ALJ Reimbursement Costs, and Computer Costs
- Fees Paid by Certification Candidates or Certifying Entities

# Fees and Payments

- Two Fees:
  - Same Fee Applies to EMTs and AEMTs
  - \$75: Those Who Need a Background Check
  - \$37: Those Who Are in the Background Check System
- Assumptions:
  - 60,000 EMTs in California
  - 30,000 Recertification's Per Year
  - 5,000 New EMTs Per Year
  - 50 Appeal Hearings Per Year
  - \$6,000 Per Hearing

# Fees and Payments

## Fee Break Down

- \$75 Fee
  - \$22 – covers the central registry costs
  - \$15 – covers the local EMS agency administrative law judge reimbursement costs.
  - \$38 – covers the administrative costs for the EMS Authority to manage the criminal background check responsibilities.

# Fees and Payments

## Fee Break Down

- \$37 Fee
  - \$22 – covers the central registry costs
  - \$15 – covers the local EMS agency administrative law judge reimbursement costs.

# Fees and Payments

## Payment of Fees

- Monthly Queries of the Central Registry
- Sort by EMTs certified and Recertified by Certifying Entity
- EMS Authority Will Invoice Each Certifying Entity
- 90-Days to Submit Payment, Unless Other Agreement is Made
- Penalty of 15% of Outstanding Balance For Late Submission of Fees
