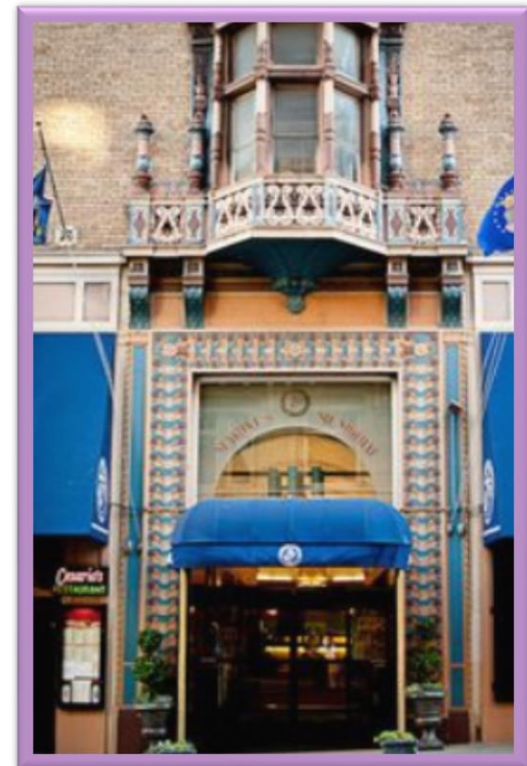
GUESTROOM RATES

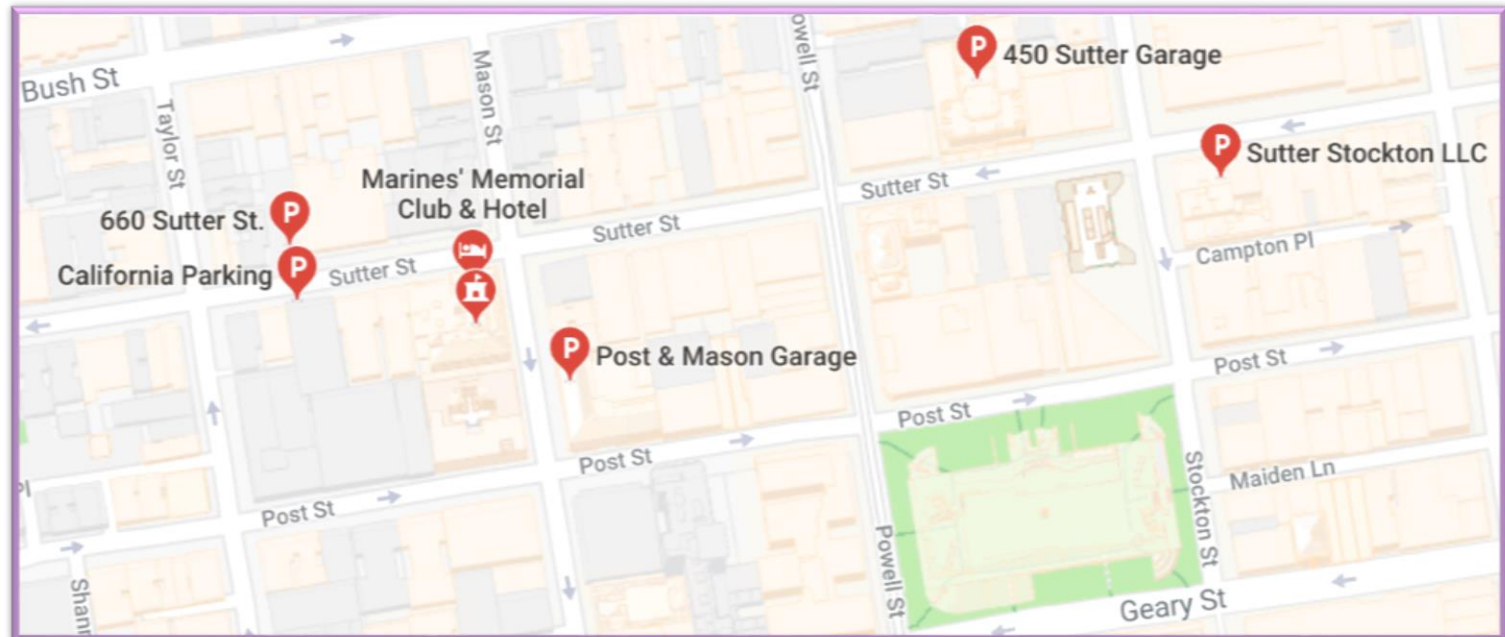
