PURPOSE:

To increase communication and consistent application of EMT certification action, this procedure provides certifying entities with a standard process for documenting final determination of certification action by the LEMSA Medical Director in the Central Registry.

REGULATION GUIDANCE:

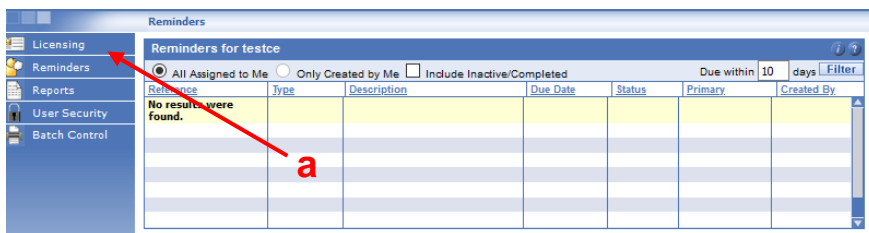
Documentation of final determination of certification action by the Medical Director must be entered into the Central Registry within 3 working days of the notice of certification action pursuant to California Code of Regulations., Title 22, Div. 9, Chapter 10, §100344 (e).

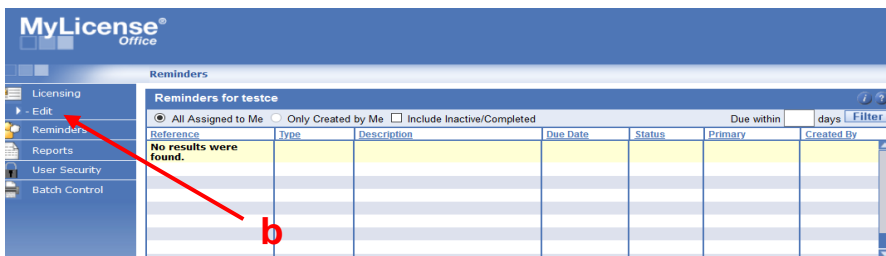

NOTE: The central registry license status panel will not communicate with the certification actions panel. It is the responsibility of the certifying entity to change the license status from Active-Probation to Active once a probation term is resolved. If the EMT certificate expires while on probation, the Central Registry will default to Expired-Probation.
