- **SUBJECT:** Update: EMS Personnel Scope of Practice EMSA Approved Hemostatic Dressings and Tourniquets

The purpose of this memo is to provide an update to EMSA's hemostatic gauze dressing and tourniquet approval process. EMSA will **no longer** be accepting requests for approval of these devices. Effective immediately, the following devices are approved for use by California EMS personnel:

EMSA, in collaboration with EMDAC, finds the Committee for Tactical Combat Casualty Care (CoTCCC) <u>list of approved tourniquets</u> are approved for California EMS personnel use.

Any hemostatic gauze is approved for use by EMS personnel under the following criteria:

- 1. The active hemostatic agent must be incorporated into the gauze (loose granules or granules delivered in an applicator, or particles sprinkled into the wound, are **not authorized**).
- 2. The active hemostatic agent must not be exothermic (heat producing) upon contact with the wound.
