CAL-MAT:

Team oriented, state-coordinated, rapid deployment teams of medical and non-medical professionals that respond to disasters. CAL-MAT is modeled after the federal Disaster Medical Assistance Team.

CAL-MAT closes the gap between local and federal response during major medical disasters, ensuring our disaster-prone state is not left unprotected.

Missions:

CAL-MAT supports a wide range of all-hazard disaster missions, providing medical care at triage sites, field treatment centers, hospitals, and other healthcare facilities.

Team Composition:

CAL-MAT teams range from small to large to meet mission objectives, which include medical response and mission support.

Mission Activities:

CAL-MAT provides medical treatment, first aid, disaster triage, nursing and medical care, immunization, prescribing and dispensing medications, wildland fire medical support, patient reception and evaluation, administrative support, warehouse logistics, and more.

What assets does CAL-MAT have?

EMSA has medical supply caches, pharmaceutical caches, equipment, and emergency response vehicles to support CAL-MAT training and deployment.

Deployment Duration:

Deployments may be up to 14 days depending on the needs of the mission.



CAL-MAT is an essential component of EMSA's mission to prevent injuries, reduce suffering, and save lives.

Paid Deployments

CAL-MAT members become paid temporary emergency hires while activated. Members receive liability protections provided by the state, along with uniforms and badges. Deployments may include coverage for travel and meals, as well as overtime opportunities.
